SUBJECT: Application for License Amendment to Delete the 3.25 Limit for Surveillance Interval Extensions

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. transmits herewith one (1) signed original and two (2) copies of a document entitled "Application for Amendment to Operating License", sworn to on December 27, 1989, together with supporting attachments. This application for an amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-26 for Indian Point Unit No. 2, if approved, would revise the Indian Point Unit No. 2 License and Technical Specifications to delete the 3.25 limit for extension of surveillance periods. In lieu of this limit any individual surveillance interval, subject to the exclusions and conditions identified in the attachment, would be limited to a factor of 1.25 applied to the minimum surveillance interval defined in the Technical Specifications.

This submittal has been prepared in accordance with NRC Generic Letter 89-14, dated August 21, 1989, which encouraged licensees to propose changes to plant Technical Specifications which eliminate the 3.25 limitation.

This application has been reviewed and approved by the Indian Point Station Nuclear Safety Committee and by Con Edison's Nuclear Facilities Safety Committee. Both committees concur that this application does not involve a significant hazards consideration pursuant to the criteria set forth in 10 CFR 50.92(c).
