Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

The Westinghouse Owners Group, of which Con Edison is a member, has committed to a program to address potential reactor vessel integrity concerns as identified in NRC Generic Letter 81-19 dated April 20, 1981. That commitment, and the description of the program, are contained in letter OG-58 dated May 14, 1981 from Robert W. Jurgensen, Chairman, Westinghouse Owners Group to you. Additionally, as described in the May 14 letter, all Westinghouse plants including Indian Point Unit No. 2 have been shown to safely sustain severe thermal shock transients, including repressurization, to beyond January, 1983 at a minimum.

Specifically, the Westinghouse Owners Group program to be completed in December, 1981, will identify whether future additional plant specific analyses and/or remedial actions may be required, and will identify the time in plant life when these additional actions may be needed. Based on the results of the program, Con Edison will provide additional detail including a schedule for reanalyses and/or remedial action if required, and their bases.
