Dear Mr. Boudreaux:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at Bayou Inspection Services, Inc. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether a radiographer employed by Bayou Inspection Services, Inc. willfully failed to wear the required personnel monitoring equipment while conducting radiographic operations in NRC jurisdiction in offshore Federal waters.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was determined to be not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to the willful aspects of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
