Enclosed is Amendment No. 09 to your NRC Material License No. 24-24619-02 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that we added Condition No. 21 to further restrict the possession of the licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35(d) for establishing financial assurance for decommissioning. This change should enhance your awareness of regulatory requirements associated with possession limits. Please note that adding this condition required renumbering your current Condition No. 21 to Condition No. 22.

In a future amendment request you should specify the Humboldt model number for the portable gauge listed in Subitem No. 9 A. and B. on your NRC Material License. Currently your license only has the gauge listed as "Humboldt Scientific, Inc. Series."

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.
