Please note that, at this time, we updated and reformatted Subitem No. 6.B. in your license to delete the exclusion of xenon-133 from your authorization of materials in 10 CFR 35.200. As a result of the revision of 10 CFR Part 35 in its entirety in 2002, NRC decided to discontinue such exclusions from the licenses it administers. There should be no effect on your licensed program as a result of this formatting change

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.


