Dear FOIA Officer:

This is a Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, request for certain information maintained by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC").

Specifically, I seek all reports from Crocker Nuclear Laboratory ("CNL") located at the University of California-Davis to the NRC for the time period of April 1982 to October 1982 regarding:

- 1.) Personnel radiation exposure film badge measurements;
- 2.) All reports of CNL training of personnel on methods for the safe handling and transportation of radioactive isotopes;
- 3.) All reports documenting UC Davis campus-to-campus transfers of radioactive isotopes where CNL was the transfer destination;
- 4.) All reports of any events associated with the transportation of radioactive isotopes where the transfer destination was CNL and the originating transfer pickup point was on the UC Davis campus; and
- 5.) All reports of any irregularities regarding any specific instances of the transportation of radioactive isotopes where the transfer destination was CNL and the originating transfer pickup point was on the UC Davis campus.

I will pay up to \$100 for search and duplication fees for the processing of this request.


