


LICENSEE:  The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> 4. During this inspection certain of your activities, as described below and/or attached, were in violation of NRC requirements and are being cited. This form is a NOTICE OF VIOLATION, which may be subject to posting in accordance with 10 CFR 19.11.  10 CFR 20.1302(b) requires, in part, that the licensee show compliance with the annual dose limits for individual members of the public in 20.1301 by demonstrating by measurement or calculation that the total effective dose equivalent to the individual likely to receive the highest dose from the licensed operation does not exceed the annual dose limit.  The inspector determined through interviews and observations that the licensee had failed to demonstrate compliance with the requirement above for the storage location of its portable nuclear gauge at the Andrews Air Force Base construction site known as the SPDF. Specifically, the gauge was found stored adjacent to office space occupied by individual members of the public, but the licensee had not demonstrated by measurement or calculation that the total effective dose equivalent to the individual likely to receive the highest dose did not exceed the annual dose limit.  The licensee took immediate corrective action by performing a survey and calculation, the results of which showed that the annual dose limit was not exceeded. The licensee also committed to the following actions to be completed on or before September 10, 2010: 1) licensee will relocate the gauge from the SPDF site, and 2) licensee will demonstrate compliance with 20.1302 by performing an evaluation of all of its licensed material storage locations and documenting the results.			
<b>Licensee's Statement of Corrective Actions for Item 4, above.</b>			
I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved).
