

The US Government awarded a contract (\$25.1M) to Rapiscan Corporation to provide and install 19 Non-Intrusive Inspection Equipment (NIIE) systems at ten Iraqi POE's and 4 Iraqi oil refineries. Of these nineteen systems ten will be their GaRDs Mobile systems that require Co-60 for operation. Included in the contract is ten days of operator training as well as five days of train the trainer courses.

These systems were purchased with US funds (what we call Iraqi Security Forces Fund. Money allocated by Congress for the reconstruction of Iraq) with the sole purpose of gifting these to the Government of Iraq upon successful installation, and training of the Iraqi operators.
