<u>ORDER</u>

(Setting Deadline to Respond to Motion for Extension of Time)

This Licensing Board is in receipt of a motion by petitioners Mark Oncavage, Dan Kipnis, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, and National Parks Conservation Association (collectively, Joint Petitioners) to extend the time in which to file replies to the answers of Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) and the NRC Staff to Joint Petitioners' petitions to intervene.¹ In their motion, Joint Petitioners request that the deadline for replies be extended from September 20, 2010 to October 4, 2010, and they represent that: (1) the other petitioners in this proceeding do not oppose the extension; (2) the NRC Staff consents to a one-week, but not a two-week extension; and (3) FPL opposes any extension.²

If any party wishes to file a response to Joint Petitioners' motion further explaining its position, such response must be filed by 12:00 P.M. on Thursday, September 16, 2010.
