
Dear Mr. Burrows:

Under correspondence dated August 3, 2010, Cameco Resources requested that the cultural resource information contained in Appendix B and C of the *Crow Butte Resources Three Crow Permit Area Class III Cultural Resource Inventory, Dawes and Sioux Counties, Nebraska*, (December 2007) “inventory report” be considered confidential information pursuant to 10 CFR §2.390(a)(3), the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 304 (16 U.S.C. 470w-3(a)) and the Nebraska Public Records Statutes (Neb. Rev. Stat. 84-712.05(13)). Further, in accordance with 10 CFR §2.390 (b)(1)(i), each page of Appendix B and Appendix C was identified as confidential.

In parallel, on August 3, 2010 Cameco Resources submitted the Technical Report and Environmental Report (ER) supporting the license amendment request. To promote compliance, Cameco Resources did not include Appendix B and Appendix C in the copy of the inventory report found in Appendix O of the ER. The only copies of Appendix B and Appendix C provided to the NRC are contained in the copy of the inventory report accompanying the affidavit. This is consistent with Section 3.8.1 of the ER.
