By application dated July 12, 2010, International Isotopes, Inc., submitted a request to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for limited authorization extending the use of the expired transportation package Model No. 5979, Certificate of Compliance No. 5979.

In connection with our review, we issued a request for additional information, dated August 26, 2010. By letter dated September 13, 2010, International Isotopes, Inc., informed the NRC staff of its withdrawal of the Model No. 5979 application, noting the limited availability of the package for use as the reason for withdrawal. The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge receipt of your request to withdraw the application and closure of TAC No. L24457.
