Freedom Of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Christian:

This is a Freedom of Information Act request under 5 CFR 552 as amended. I am not a commercial requester, and this request will contribute important information the benefits the public good. Specifically, the information will support claims for former GSI nuclear weapons workers at the Illinois site under EEOICPA 2000 as amended.

This request addresses Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) documents that are related to the Eddystone Division (Pennsylvania) of General Steel Castings [GSI] (*aka* General Steel Industries, Inc.) in the 1952 to 1964 time frame. Specifically, I request the following:

1. Any record of a radiation monitoring program at Eddystone in PA that yielded individual worker film badge data (photons, beta, neutrons) or site air monitoring data.

2. Any <u>by-product materials licenses</u> related to the following radioactive isotopes that might have been used in nondestructive testing (NDT) activities at the Eddystone Division of GSI in Pennsylvania held between the years 1952 and 1964: namely, **cobalt-60** (Co-60), **iridium-192** (Ir-192), or **radium-226** (Ra-226).

3. Any AEC or joint AEC-Pennsylvania State radiation agency inspection reports 1952-1964 at the GSI Eddystone Division in Pennsylvania that related to a radiation safety program.

4. Any records pertaining to the GSI Eddystone Division 24 Mev Betatron x-ray particle accelerator and Betatron building that housed the machine 1952 to 1964. This unit was manufactured by Allis-Chalmers in West Allis, Wisconsin.

5. Any records that relate to a transfer of the GSI Eddystone Division Betatron 24 Mev x-ray machine and/or Co-60 80 Curie NDT source from Pennsylvania to the GSI facility located in Granite City, IL, around 1962-64.

6. Any records that relate to decommissioning of the GSI Eddystone Betatron building after the Betatron was moved to GSI in Illinois in 1962-64.
