
Dear Mr. Caldwell:

Professional Service Industries, Inc. (PSI) is in receipt of a letter dated August 17, 2010 signed by Ms. Tamara E. Bloomer with the above referenced Notice of Violation (NOV) as an attachment. Pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201, attached is your copy of PSI's response.

I notice on Ms. Bloomer's letter that the State of Illinois and the State of Florida (presumably the Illinois Emergency Management Agency [IEMA] and the Florida Department of Health, respectively) were provided a copy of her letter and the NOV. I question why these two agencies were included since neither agency has any regulatory jurisdiction in the compliance matter. Regardless, I am copying both Agreement State agencies (as well as the Puerto Rico Department of Health) on this correspondence.
