SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JULY 27, 2010, PUBLIC MEETING WITH
UNITED STATES - ADVANCED PRESSURIZED WATER REACTOR
DESIGN CENTERED WORKING GROUP TO DISCUSS
STANDARDIZATION OF COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATIONS

On July 27, 2010, a public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the United States - Advanced Pressurized Water Reactor (US-APWR) Design Centered Working Group (DCWG). The purpose of this meeting was to discuss changes to the current Reference-Combined License Application (R-COLA) standardization format, and the Subsequent-Combined License Application (S-COLA) standardization format. A list of meeting attendees is provided as Enclosure 1. Luminant Generation Company, LLC's (Luminant) public meeting handout is presented in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under accession number ML102090560 and is provided as Enclosure 2.

The US-APWR DCWG, consisting of Luminant, Mitsubishi Heavy Industries, Ltd. (MHI), and Dominion Virginia Power (Dominion), discussed the history and the recent changes to this organization. The US-APWR DCWG was originally established in April 2007, with Luminant and MHI as the original members. Luminant represented the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant, Units 3 and 4, R-COLA and MHI and Mitsubishi Nuclear Energy Systems (MNES) represented the US-APWR design certification application. By letter dated June 28, 2010, Dominion submitted its COLA to use the US-APWR reactor technology. During this same month, Dominion joined this DCWG as a S-COLA.

Next, the US-APWR DCWG presented the COLA standard left margin notations that will be used for both the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant COLA and the North Anna Power Station S-COLA. MNES described how the R-COLA would differentiate between the standard and plant specific supplemental information and departures. Dominion presented how the S-COLA would incorporate standard information from the R-COLA, using the left hand notation. Finally, Luminant discussed its proposal to change the left hand notation to "Standard" where the Dominion adopts the "Standard" review in its S-COLA.
