Enclosed is Amendment No. 27 to your NRC Material License No. 13-18524-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

**The letter dated June 11, 2010, requested that we add Tony A. Findley, M.D to your NRC byproduct materials license. We were unable to approve Dr. Findlay, as an Authorized User (AU) on your license at this time. The information in your letter dated June 11, 2010, was insufficient to complete our review.**

**If you wish to pursue this request, please provide the information requested below, addressed to my attention, and marked as described above, including "control number 572983."**

**No information was provided for what modalities that you would like to have Dr. Findley approved for on your material license. Dr. Findley is not listed as an AU on the St. Mary's Medical Center's NRC Materials License No. 13-03226-04 you referenced in your letter dated June 11, 2010. Also no board certifications, training records or documentation of training were provided for Dr. Findley.**


