The Health Physics Society (HPS), a professional organization whose mission is excellence in the science and practice of radiation safety, hereby requests an extension to the comment period for the Revised Draft Safety Culture Policy Statement (75FR57081) to December 15, 2010. HPS is aware and supportive of a similar request by the American Association of Physicists in Medicine.

HPS has been very involved in the stakeholder activities associated with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) effort to develop a Safety Culture Policy Statement.
