Dear Dr. Best:

In "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" dated August 14, 2010, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate St. Louis PET Centers, LLC NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed the final status surveys of the program. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and no residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities remains.
