In Reference 1 Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (Westinghouse) submitted the most recent revision to the Hematite Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan (FNMCP) for decommissioning. Attachment 1 herein provides a new revision to that FNMCP in light of the Westinghouse - U. S. Government Settlement Agreement-In-Principle.

Changes to the Reference 1 FNMCP are denoted by vertical lines in the right margin of Attachment 1. Attachment 2 provides explanations of those changes. Attachment 3 provides a matrixed comparison of the provisions of the revised FNMCP versus the regulatory requirements of 10 CFR 74 Subpart E with respect to the material addressed in the Westinghouse - U. S. Government Settlement Agreement-In-Principle.

Attachments 1 through 3 contain information concerning the Hematite facility's material control and accounting program for special nuclear material. Therefore, those attachments are withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(d).
