Washington Demilitarization Company (WDC) is submitting this letter to request two amendments be made to Material License 09-27724-01 (Docket No. 030-35960).

WDC is submitting a notice of change of Radiation Safety Officer for Material License No. 03-27724-01. Effective September 16, 2010, the RSO for this license will be Mr. Marty J. Buell. Mr. Buell has completed required training and may be reached at (870) 541-4333.

WDC is also requesting that Line Item 17 in Material License 09-27724-01 be amended to reflect that (WDC) the licensee is permitted to relocate and remove from service the source holder that contains the sealed source provided that Ohmart-VEGA radiation safety trained personnel or personnel under the direct supervision of Ohmart-VEGA radiation trained personnel perform the relocation and/or removal from service. In the event that personnel perform the removal/relocation work under an Ohmart-VEGA radiation safety trained person, the personnel performing the work will have documented radiation safety training. *physical presence.*

WDC is preparing to begin the end of operations and part of the decommissioning and closure process is to properly dispose of the seven radiation gauges on site. Upon approval of this amendment, our plan is to remove the gauges from their operational location, perform Industrial Hygiene sampling and monitoring to ensure there is no chemical agent contamination and turn over to a properly licensed contractor for disposal/re-use. Exterior decontamination will be greatly improved and quicker if we are permitted to remove the gauges from the machinery they are affixed to currently. This also allows WDC to ensure potentially chemical agent contaminated items are handled by personnel that are properly trained to handle chemical agents.
