SUBJECT: FORMAL INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PHENOMENA IDENTIFICATION
AND RANKING TABLE EXPERT PANEL FOR FIRE-INDUCED CIRCUIT
FAILURES

Dear Mr. Crane:

The purpose of this letter is to officially begin our Phenomena Identification and Ranking Table (PIRT) activity for fire-induced circuit failures as applied to Nuclear Power Plant applications. Our first meeting of the PIRT panel will take place in November 2010 at the U.S. NRC Headquarters Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (RES) Church Street building in Rockville, Maryland. Scheduling of this meeting will be based on the availability of the panel members. Detailed instructions, scheduling information, and directions will be provided shortly from Brookhaven National Laboratory (BNL), the facilitator for the PIRT meetings.

At our first meeting we will provide details as to how we plan to conduct the PIRT activity. Mano Subudhi from BNL will be moderating panel discussions, and will be supported by James Higgins and Kenneth Sullivan, also of the BNL Staff. Mr. Subudhi will be in contact with you and will provide background information. Because the specific expertise of the panelists does vary, we will also provide a range of background material intended to orient you to the nuclear plant applications of interest. For some panelists the background information will be redundant to their prior knowledge, but we do want to ensure that all participants are provided with the same general foundation upon which the PIRT activity will build.

The PIRT panel will be supported by a number of technical area experts. General background relative to the nuclear plant applications will be provided mainly by members of the NRC staff including, in particular, Gabriel Taylor and myself. Additional support staff may be on hand to answer your questions and to support the panel's deliberations as needed.
