


The purpose of this modification is to increase the level of effort (LOE) to add the Regulatory Information Conference System (RICS) to the list of systems that need to be C&Aed. The following is revised:

1. The LOE is increased by 742.3 staff hours.
2. The ceiling is increased by \$ 88,108.84, from \$57,000.78 to \$145,109.62.
3. Provide incremental funding in the amount of \$47,000.00, thereby increasing the obligated amount from \$57,000 to \$104,000.00.

Accordingly, the following revisions are hereby made:

1. Section **1.0 OBJECTIVE**, adds the following bullet:
 - RICS – It is expected to be a moderate system (Confidentiality Low, Integrity Moderate, and Availability Low)
2. Section **2.0 BACKGROUND**, adds the following paragraph:

RICS

The Regulatory Information Conference (RIC) is a highly anticipated event for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and its stakeholders. As the largest annual gathering sponsored by the NRC, the RIC brings together the public; licensees; state, local and federal government; the national laboratories; federal agencies; non-governmental organizations; industry; and the media.

Our mission to ensure adequate protection of public health and safety, promote the common defense and security, and protect the environment is best achieved through regular communications and collaboration with our stakeholders. The RIC provides a valuable forum for doing just that. The purpose of the RIC is to share information on regulatory issues, recent research, rulemakings; new process and procedure improvements, lessons learned, and other areas of interest. We also look to RIC attendees for feedback on our planned and current activities and suggestions for how we might be an even more decisive regulator and further improve our effectiveness. We are looking forward to three days of engaging and productive dialogue across a broad range of issues.

This system is hosted here at the NRC and at a contractor facility in Silver Spring MD.
