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MEETING REPORT

DATE: September 9, 2010

PURPOSE: This meeting was held at the request of Strata Energy (Strata) to discuss its proposed Ross In Situ Recovery Project in Wyoming.

BACKGROUND:

Strata submitted a Letter of Intent to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff on October 5, 2009. This letter notified the staff that Strata intends to submit an application to operate an in situ recovery (ISR) facility in Crook County, Wyoming. During the meeting, Strata indicated that it is on track to submit its application in December 2010.

DISCUSSION:

NRC staff read the opening statement for the meeting and Strata proceeded with its slide presentation of the project. Slides presented at this meeting are included as Attachment 3. Strata's presentation discussed the following aspects of the project: (i) ongoing licensing activities; (ii) baseline program milestones; (iii) status of technical and environmental reports; and (iv) unique conditions at the site.

ACTIONS:

During the meeting, Strata asked for examples of an NRC review and approval of an alternate restoration schedule under 10 CFR 40.42. The staff notes that Crow Butte Resources submitted an alternate schedule request on July 24, 2009, and that the NRC approved this alternate schedule request on February 18, 2010. These documents are available in ADAMS under accession numbers ML092220668 and ML092510030, respectively.
