

Recent Operator License Examination Records

On August 2 through 13, 2010, operator trainees at Calvert Cliffs were administered examinations to determine their knowledge and abilities related to receiving reactor operator or senior reactor operator licenses. Nuclear Regulatory Commission inspectors were present for the examination process. In accordance with NUREG 1021, we understand that a copy of the written examination and answer key will become public records available on ADAMS. We would like to request a delay in making these examination records public. As part of our evaluation of licensed operator trainees, we routinely use the previous Nuclear Regulatory Commission-administered examination to evaluate the trainees. The next group of trainees is scheduled to be evaluated in the late summer of 2012. Therefore, we request that the recently used examination not be made a public record until after August, 2012 to prevent access to the examination questions.
