Enclosed is Amendment No. 92 amending NRC Material License No. 13-02752-03 in accordance with your letter dated July 27, 2010 and subsequent letter dated September 27, 2010. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

This amendment approves the release of Environmental Management Facility located on 640 Union Drive in Indianapolis, IN for unrestricted use. Based on review of the information provided in your request, we have concluded that any residual byproduct material remaining in the facility is below the NRC's unrestricted use dose limits specified in 10 CFR Part 20, subpart E "Radiological Criteria for License Termination." An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(iii).

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
