Thank you for bringing an error in your last license amendment to our attention. Subitem 8.E. shows 5 curies for each isotope instead of 15 curies per isotope. Enclosed is a corrected copy of your license. We apologize for any inconvenience this error may have caused you.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
