On October 14, 2010, the State of New York (New York) filed an unopposed Motion for an extension of the deadline within which it may reply to answers filed on October 12, 2010 by Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. and the NRC Staff to New York's September 15, 2010 motion for leave to file additional bases for the previously-admitted contention NYS-25.<sup>1</sup>
