Alliance Solution Group (ASG), Inc. is seeking access to records under the Freedom of Information Act and the Privacy Act. ASG is a small, service-disabled, veteran-owned business that offers homeland security solutions to federal, state, and local government agencies as well as private industry.

ASG is currently under contract to perform Toxic Industrial Chemical (TIC) and Toxic Industrial Materials (TIM) vulnerability assessment at Francis E. Warren Air Force Base, Laramie County, Wyoming. If any information is to be withheld, please notify me and ASG will request the USAF file a separate request. In order to complete the assessment, we need to identify and quantify any information on radioactive materials stored/used within 20 miles of the base. We are requesting information on the companies or businesses that currently have radioactive material licenses/permits within the cities of Buford, Burns, Carpenter, Granite Hillsdale, Horse Creek, and South Greeley (Albany and Laramie Counties) and the city of Carr, Colorado (Weld County). If possible, please provide a copy of the license/permit indicating the specific isotope and maximum activity authorized for each item. This information can be provided electronically(CD) if available.
