SUBJECT: TECHNICAL MEETING SUMMARY

On October 12, 2010, representatives of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and Stepan Company met in Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss classification and disposal alternatives for soil with low radioactivity concentration at the Stepan Maywood, New Jersey site. This site is an NRC licensed facility that is currently being remediated by the U.S Army Corps of Engineers under the Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP). Stepan informed the staff that the soil disposal alternatives outlined in the NRC's letter dated October 6, 2010, [ML102000260] were previously evaluated and determined not to be viable options. Given that FUSRAP cleanup activities are anticipated to be completed in 2011, another alternative discussed was for Stepan to await the completion of the license termination process. The NRC cautioned Stepan concerning their proposal [ML102640433] to mix the existing soil stockpile with rubble material. Stepan agreed to withdraw their proposal to the NRC for mixing waste material.
