### MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

(Administrative Matters Relating to Board Questions and Protective Order Filings)

In the Licensing Board's October 7, 2010 issuance, the Board established a schedule for the safety-related portion of this mandatory/uncontested hearing under which the Board is to provide questions for the NRC staff and applicant AREVA Enrichment Services, LLC, (AES) to answer on or before November 12, 2010. <u>See</u> Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Initial General Schedule; Revision to Uncontested/Mandatory Hearing Procedures; Inviting Written Limited Appearance Statements and Participation by Interested Governmental Entities) (Oct. 7, 2010) app. A at 2 (unpublished). Relative to those potential questions, the Board requests that the following be done on or before <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>October 27, 2010</u>:

 The staff should provide the Board with a copy of, or the ADAMS accession number citation to, (a) the March 31, 2005 letter from the Department of Energy (DOE) to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC); and (b) the May 6, 2002 interagency agreement between NRC and DOE, both of which are referenced on page 1-8 of the NRC staff's September 2010 safety evaluation report, NUREG-1951. 2. Since the Board currently contemplates that its questions may involve nonpublic information (e.g., official use only), the staff and applicant AES each should provide an e-mail to the Office of the Secretary (hearingdocket@nrc.gov) and Licensing Board Panel law clerk Jonathan Eser (jonathan.eser@nrc.gov) that indicates whether any of its counsel/representatives now on the public submission E-Filling service list for this proceeding should not be provided with Board issuances via nonpublic "protective order" E-Filing service.
