SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Mr. Bergschultz:

In letters dated NRC July 13, 2010 (with attachments), September 30, 2010 (with attachments), October 12, 2010 (with attachments), and NRC Form 314 dated September 30, 2010 (with attachments), you indicated that you wished to release the location at 4135 Technology Parkway, Sheboygan, Wisconsin for unrestricted use.

You also indicated that all activities authorized by license number 48-18608-02 have ceased and that radioactive materials possessed under this license have been transferred to AECOM USA, Inc. and AECOM, Inc. under Wisconsin license number 079-1308-01; AECOM Technical Services, Inc. under South Carolina license number 866; AECOM Technical Services, Inc. under Iowa license number 322-1-07-PG; Aguinaga Technical Services under Wisconsin license number 117-1005-01; and Troxler Electronics Laboratories, Inc. under North Carolina license number 032-0182-1.

The NRC staff has reviewed your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your former location of use and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required for this location and it is suitable for unrestricted use.

Based on these conditions, your NRC license number 48-18608-02 is hereby terminated.
