NEXTERA ENERGY SEABROOK, LLC  
(Seabrook Station, Unit 1)

This proceeding involves an application by NextEra Energy Seabrook, LLC for a twenty-year renewal of license 50-443, which authorizes NextEra Energy Seabrook, LLC to operate Seabrook Station, Unit 1 located near Portsmouth, New Hampshire. The current operating license expires on March 15, 2030. In response to a July 21, 2010 Notice of Opportunity for Hearing published in the Federal Register (75 Fed. Reg. 42,462), two petitions to intervene were submitted. One petition is a joint filing by Beyond Nuclear, Seacoast Anti-Pollution League, and New Hampshire Sierra Club; the other petition is a filing by Friends of the Coast and New England Coalition.
