Dear Administrative Judges:

On October 25, 2010, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) issued a Memorandum and Order (Order) addressing administrative matters relating to Board questions and protective order filings. The Board requested that, on or before Wednesday, October 27, 2010, the parties respond to two requests for information, which the NRC Staff addresses below.

The Board requested that the Staff provide it with a copy of, or the ADAMS accession number citations to, two documents referenced on page 1-8 of the NRC Staff's September 2010 Safety Evaluation Report (SER), NUREG-1951. The ADAMS accession numbers for the two referenced documents are as follows, (a) ML050980235 – the March 31, 2005, letter from the Department of Energy (DOE) to the NRC; and (2) ML021610114 – the May 6, 2002, interagency agreement between NRC and DOE.

Pursuant to the Board's second request in the October 25 Order, the NRC Staff, in a separate email to the Office of the Secretary and the Licensing Board Panel law clerk, sent the requested information on Tuesday, October 26, 2010, apprising the Office of the Secretary and the Board's law clerk whether any of the NRC Staff's counsel/representatives on the public submission E-Filing service list for this proceeding should not be provided with Board issuances via nonpublic "protective order" E-Filing service.
