MEMORANDUM

(Seeking Commission Designation of Representative  
to Advise and Assist Licensing Board  
Regarding Classifying and Safeguarding Information)

Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.904, the Licensing Board respectfully requests that the Commission designate a representative to advise and assist the Board with respect to security classification of information and the safeguards to be observed.

The Board was established to conduct the mandatory hearing on the application of AREVA Enrichment Services, LLC, (AES) for a license to enrich uranium by the gas centrifuge process at a facility to be located in Bonneville County, Idaho. As was stated in the hearing notice for this proceeding, AES has submitted portions of its application that are classified. See Notice of Receipt of Application for License; Notice of Consideration of Issuance of License; Notice of Hearing and Commission Order and Order Imposing Procedures for Access to Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information and Safeguards Information for Contention Preparation; In the Matter of Areva Enrichment Services, LLC (Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility) 74 Fed. Reg. 38,052, 38,058, 38,059 (July 30, 2009) (CLI-09-15, 70 NRC 1, 20, 21 (2009)). Accordingly, the Board may need to seek advice and assistance concerning, among other

things, how to address the enrichment process as openly and transparently as practicable (see 10 C.F.R. § 2.328), while avoiding disclosure of Restricted Data or National Security Information (see 10 C.F.R. Part 2, Subpart I).
