

Dear Edwin,

Please find enclosed the applicant questions and NRC-approved clarifications for the North Anna Units 1 & 2 2010 RO-SRO Initial License Exam. Note that the clarifying information for the first three items was provided to all 15 applicants. The clarifying information for the last three items was provided only to the individuals who asked the questions.

<u>Item #</u>	<u>Question/NRC-approved clarification</u>
26	Christopher Call (docket #23539) asked, "Is CC cross-connected or split out?" Clarification, "Assume the Unit-1 and Unit-2 Component Cooling systems are in their normal configuration."
16	Luke Weatherholz (docket #23545) asked, "What is containment pressure?" Clarification, "Answer the question based on the <u>current</u> plant conditions stated in the question."
39	John Baltor (docket #23538) asked, "Is the first condition (reactor power stable at 50%) as indicated by N-44? Did steady-state power go from 50% from 48%?" Clarification, "Indicated reactor power is based on all available indications of reactor power."
86	Jonathan Allen (docket #23532) asked, "Can the steam generator PORV be cycled locally with the handwheel?" Clarification, "Answer the question to the best of your ability with the information provided."
64	Marcus Hofmann (docket #23534) asked, "What is the ramp rate?" Clarification, "Answer the question to the best of your ability with the information provided."
26	Jason Russell (docket #23537) asked, "Is this asking what is the initial affect following all automatic actuations that occur as a result of this event?" Clarification, "Yes."
