APPROVAL OF ALTERNATE FINANCIAL ASSURANCE ARRANGEMENTS AND
FINAL FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS FOR DECOMMISSIONING, HONEYWELL
METROPOLIS WORKS

Dear Mr. Smith:

The purpose of this letter is to make a correction to Honeywell's Material License No. SUB-526, which was transmitted by our letter dated October 14, 2010 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML101870106). In the October 14, 2010 letter, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approved Honeywell's executed copies of the financial instruments and a Certification of Financial Assurance, which were submitted for NRC's review in a letter dated April 6, 2010 (ADAMS Accession No. ML100980032).

As discussed in the staff's letter, dated October 14, 2010, based on the findings discussed in the safety evaluation report, License Conditions (LC) 26 and 27 contained in Honeywell Materials License, No. SUB-526, were removed, as Honeywell is no longer required to have a self-guarantee in place. In addition to the above revisions, LC 18.G, "Exemption Request dated February 9, 2007, for relief from some of the Decommissioning Funding provisions of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 40.64," should have been removed. The enclosure contains Material License SUB-526, Amendment 6-1, reflecting the deletion of LC 18.G.
