This proposed rule is an important step in requiring that uranium conversion and deconversion facilities conduct integrated safety analyses similar to that required for other fuel cycle facilities. The staff properly evaluated stakeholder input and technical information from OSHA and EPA in reducing the proposed threshold of 10,000 kg of UF<sub>6</sub> to 2,000 kg. If additional information becomes available that warrants establishing a UF<sub>4</sub> threshold for requiring an ISA, the staff should communicate that to the Commission.
