Reference: USNRC letter to Exelon Nuclear Texas Holdings, LLC, Early Site Permit Application Online Reference Portal, dated October 26, 2010

On March 25, 2010, Exelon Nuclear Texas Holdings, LLC (Exelon) submitted an Application for an Early Site Permit (ESP) for the Victoria County Station (VCS) site.

To improve the efficiency of the ESP environmental and safety reviews, Exelon and the NRC staff discussed the use of an online reference portal that would provide NRC and NRC-contracted staff limited read-only access to basis documents and other reference material cited in the Exelon VCS ESP application. In the referenced letter, the NRC established conditions that must be implemented for use of the online reference portal to be acceptable. Exelon hereby confirms that the conditions listed in the referenced letter, as modified below, will be maintained throughout the duration of the Exelon VCS ESP application review process:

- The online reference portal will be password-protected and passwords will be assigned to staff directly involved in the VCS ESP application review on a need-to-know basis;
- The online reference portal will be sufficiently secure to prevent staff from printing, saving, or downloading any documents (note – Exelon cannot prevent a user from printing a single page via screen print or from taking a picture of the computer screen with a camera); and
- Conditions of use of the online reference portal will be displayed on the log-in screen and will require concurrence by each user of the online reference portal.

These conditions must be maintained throughout the duration of the Exelon VCS ESP application review process. The referenced letter further states that Exelon will be formally requested to submit on the NRC docket those documents that are identified by the staff as necessary to conduct the review of the ESP application.

Exelon understands that staff given password access to the electronic reading room will also be informed of the conditions of use by the NRC project managers.

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
