Dear Mr. Frick:

This is in reference to your letter dated July 20, 2010 requesting an amendment to your Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 53-29402-01. In order to issue the amendment we need the following additional information:

1. The information provided for Mr. Arturo Gutierrez is not sufficient for him to be named as the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). In order to name Mr. Gutierrez as the RSO, please provide documentation showing either:
  - a. The individual was previously identified as an RSO on a NRC or Agreement State license; or
  - b. Completed a specialty board certification recognized by the NRC; or
  - c. Has completed a structured educational program; AND
  - d. Has a written attestation by a preceptor RSO.

The attached NRC form 313a(RSO) can be helpful when providing the information needed.

2. If Mr. Gutierrez is not qualified by any of the aforementioned pathways, please name a qualified individual following one of the pathways described above.

Current NRC regulations and guidance are included on the NRC's website at [www.nrc.gov](http://www.nrc.gov); select **Nuclear Materials; Medical, Academic, and Industrial Uses of Nuclear Material; Regulations, Guidance, and Communications**. You may also obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-866-512-1800. The GPO is open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays).

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region IV Office and refer to Mail Control No. 573288. Please note that you may reply to this letter by return e-mail if you send the file in a PDF format. Your reply may be in writing by facsimile (817-860-8263). Please respond by October 28, 2010. If we do not receive a reply from you within the time allotted, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
