Dear Mr. Braue,

This letter is in response to your request to terminate NRC Exempt Distribution License No. 10-23967-01E as indicated on your NRC Form 314 "Certificate of Disposition of Materials" dated September 15, 2010. Before we can terminate the Worldwide Specialty Lamp license, we need a final product transfer report as required by Condition 12 of your license and 10 CFR 32.16. Worldwide Specialty Lamps' last transfer report was dated January 25, 2010.

Condition 12 of License 10-23967-01E (Amendment 01) requires submittal of periodic reports as specified in Section 32.16, 10 CFR Part 32.

Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 32, section 32.16, states the following:

- Each person licensed under §32.14 shall maintain records of all transfers of byproduct material and file a report with the Director of the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs by an appropriate method listed in §30.6(a) of this chapter, including in the address: ATTN: Document Control Desk/Exempt Distribution.
- Per §32.16 (c)(2), licensees who permanently discontinue activities authorized by the license issued under §32.14 shall file a report for the current calendar year within 30 days after ceasing distribution.
- Also, per §32.16(d), if no transfers of byproduct material have been made under § 32.14 during the reporting period, the report must so indicate.

As a minimum, you should file the report by one of the methods listed in Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 30, section 30.6(a). In addition, to facilitate the processing of your amendment request, please send a copy of your report directly to me at the following address:
