Shaw Environmental and Infrastructure, Inc., intends to perform licensed work activities at the following location on November 9, 2010:

1339 Tolland Turnpike
Manchester, CT 06041

Work activities will consist of removal and packaging of a suspected damaged tritium exit sign, collection of smear samples to assess potential levels of tritium contamination, and pre-emptive decontamination. Based on experience at similar sites, potential removable tritium contamination levels are expected to be 1,000 dpm/100cm² or less. All wastes from the sampling and decontamination activities will be packaged along with the potentially damaged sign for return shipment to the manufacturer.
