This letter is a follow-up to my conversation with Ms. Ramona Torres of your staff on October 4, 2010, concerning the maintenance of relevant documents by your library. These documents are related to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staffs review of the application by South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company for renewal of the operating license for South Texas Project (STP), Units 1 and 2, for an additional 20 years. The application was received by the NRC in November 2010.

The NRC staff appreciates your willingness to assist the public in participating in the license renewal application process. As discussed, your support would consist of providing approximately two feet of shelf space in your reference section, which would be used for making documents related to the NRC staffs environmental review of the license renewal application available to the public. We will place the Bay City Public Library on our distribution list for documents and notices related to the review of STP, Units 1 and 2, application. After the application process is completed in approximately two years, you may dispose of these documents.


