AMENDMENT APPLICATION TO MODIFY LICENSE CONDITION 21

OF USNRC SOURCE MATERIALS LICENSE, HONEYWELL

METROPOLIS WORKS

Attached is Honeywell's application for amendment to Metropolis Works USNRC Source Materials License SUB-526 to revise License Condition 21 (LC 21).

The existing license condition LC 21 states:

Honeywell shall within 10 days of receipt of source material, report to the NMMSS database, the shipper's value of the natural uranium. Shipper's values shall be reported (blocks 1 through 27s of DOE/NRC form 741) as required in Section 2.1.1 of NUREG/BR-0006. To ensure that the values reported are correctly posted, Honeywell shall compare, on a monthly basis, its weights of natural uranium it has received with weight values contained in NMMSS database, and provide corrections as necessary. The final quantity determination, as agreed upon with the supplier, shall be reported to the NMMSS database within 10 days of the date on which the agreement is finalized.

The revised LC 21 shall state:

Honeywell shall within 10 days of receipt of source material, report to the NMMSS database, the shipper's value of the natural uranium. Shipper's values shall be reported (blocks 1 through 27s of DOE/NRC form 741) as required in Section 2.1.1 of NUREG/BR-0006. The final quantity determination, as agreed upon with the supplier, shall be reported to the NMMSS database within 10 days of the date on which the agreement is finalized.

Over the past few years, Honeywell has been undergoing considerable organizational changes, including increased resource availability and competence. According to the latest inventory management program audit, these changes have resulted in significant progress in the inventory management, including NMMSS reporting and record reconciliation process improvement. Following the programmatic audit, Honeywell initiated a regulatory basis and effectiveness analysis of its material accountability process. This analysis also included consultations with the NMMSS staff and peer industry organizations.

This analysis determined that the only Honeywell License Condition related to the inventory management is LC 21. This condition reiterates 10 CFR 40.64(a) requirement that "...each licensee who receives the material shall submit a Nuclear Material Transaction Report in computer-readable format in accordance with instructions within ten (10) days after the material is received..." and proscribes that Honeywell reports to NMMSS database shall be compliant with NUREG/BR-0006 requirements.

In addition, LC 21 requires that Honeywell "...compare, on a monthly basis, its weights of natural uranium it has received with weight values contained in NMMSS database, and provide corrections as necessary." This stipulation was included in the Honeywell's Source Materials License at the time of its renewal in 2007 as an attempt to improve the site's inventory management. This stipulation does not represent any regulatory requirement or guideline. Our analysis of 3-year operation under the renewed license indicates that, the natural uranium weights comparison may be useful for NMMSS-licensee data management. At the same time, our communications with NMMSS staff and other licensees indicate that uranium weight comparisons performed on a mandated monthly basis are largely exceeding NMMSS staff expectations and industry practices. Moreover, the weight reconciliations conducted with a proscribed monthly frequency require substantial Honeywell and NMMSS resource investments which appear to be unwarranted and consume resources that could be otherwise directed to other program areas.

This proposed change had been reviewed and evaluated using Honeywell's configuration management process as described in 2.6.3. of the License Application. As determined by this evaluation, the proposed change will not adversely affect the level of safety and material control as described in the License Application and/or any other licensing basis document.

Honeywell will ensure compliance with regulatory and license requirements and policies and procedures applicable to material security, control and inventory management. The site will continue to implement improvements in its material control and accountability programs, including establishing an alternative uranium weight comparison process on an "as warranted" basis.

Based on aforementioned considerations, we request to modify License Condition 21 by removing the requirement "...compare, on a monthly basis, its weights of natural uranium it has received with weight values contained in NMMSS database, and provide corrections as necessary."
