Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) submitted a Combined License (COL) Application for two AP1000 pressurized water reactor units to be located at the Turkey Point site, designated Turkey Point Units 6 & 7, located in Miami-Dade County, FL on June 30, 2009 (Reference 1). By letter dated September 4, 2009, the NRC informed FPL that the NRC accepted the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 COL Application (Reference 2).

To improve the efficiency of the environmental and safety reviews, FPL and the NRC staff discussed the use of an online reference portal that would allow the NRC staff and its contractors, Pacific Northwest National Laboratories and Information Systems Laboratories, Inc. limited read-only access to the basis documents and other reference materials cited in the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 COL Application. The online reference portal would allow the NRC staff to audit basis documents to determine whether the information included in the documents supports the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 COL Application. Documents identified as necessary for analysis of the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 COL Application or development of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) will be identified by the NRC staff.

By NRC letter dated August 31, 2010, the NRC requested FPL establish an online reference portal that would allow the NRC staff and its contractors, Pacific Northwest National Laboratories and Information Systems Laboratories, Inc. limited read-only access to the basis documents and other reference materials cited in the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 COL Application (Reference 3).

Florida Power & Light Company

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FPL agrees to provide an online reference portal for NRC use with the following conditions placed on the use of the portal:

- The online reference portal will be password-protected and passwords will be assigned to staff directly involved in the COL review on a need-to-know basis.
- The online reference portal will be sufficiently secure to prevent staff from printing, saving, or downloading any documents.
- Conditions of use of the online reference portal will be displayed on the log-in screen and will require concurrence by each user, prior to initial use.

The above conditions will be maintained throughout the duration of the Turkey Point Unit 6 & 7 COL Application review process.
