**Re: Revision of the Lost Soldier Notice of Intent

Dear Dr. Miller,

On March 2, 2009, Ur-Energy informed the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of our intent to amend the Lost Creek license by adding the Lost Soldier facility as a satellite with a submittal date of October 2009. However, the continual slippage of NRC's schedule for issuing the license for the Lost Creek Project has made it difficult to predict when submittal of the amendment will be possible. Therefore, with this letter, Ur-Energy USA Inc. is notifying the NRC of our intent to submit the license amendment request for Lost Soldier in March of 2012.

The Lost Soldier Project is currently held by NFU Wyoming, LLC which, like Lost Creek ISR, LLC, is a 100% owned subsidiary of Ur-Energy USA Inc. The NRC Docket Number 40-9068 and Technical Assignment Control Number LU0142 were originally issued for both the Lost Creek and Lost Soldier Projects.
