Dear Mr. Morris:

This refers to the telephone conversation between you and me on October 13, 2010, regarding the need for you to submit a complete, signed (by the regulatory authority in Maryland) and most recently amended copy of the Maryland License No. MD-13-020-01 for North East Technical Services, Inc. (NETSI), the licensee who took possession of your Troxler Model No. 3411 portable gauging device.

The requirements in 10 CFR 30.41 and 30.51 require that we obtain this information in order to process your termination request. Please note that Maryland is an Agreement State and, as such, we do not have access to its licenses in order to verify that NETSI is authorized to possess your gauge.

As discussed with you on October 13, 2010, we have voided your letter dated July 15, 2010, transmitted to us via facsimile on July 23, 2010, in order to enable you to prepare a complete response without time constraints. "Void" means that we have taken your request out of our active database to provide you with the time to respond appropriately. It is often regarded as a "good thing." This action is taken without prejudice to future resubmission of a license amendment request.

If you wish to pursue the termination of your NRC license, please submit the requested copy of the NETSI license issued by Maryland in writing addressed to my attention and refer to it as "additional information to control number 573363." We will then continue our review.

Please also be reminded of the provisions in 10 CFR 30.9(a), "Completeness and accuracy of information,"..."(a) Information provided to the Commission by an applicant for a license or by a licensee or information required by statute or by the Commission's regulations, orders, or license conditions to be maintained by the applicant or the licensee shall be complete and accurate in all material respects."
