Behram, as you noted in Section 3.6.1.2.1 the reference for (University of Wyoming 2004 and 2008) is identified, however as we noted in our February 23, 2010 Comments on the Draft SEIS page 22, first comment, there is no such reference in the SEIS section 3.14. It is however, again referenced on page 4-38, Section 4.6.1.1.2.1 and subsequently in the reference section 4.15 of the SEIS. Below is the language out of the ER as you see we make no reference to the University Of Wyoming 2004 and 2008. The language in the ER and SEIS is similar but not the same. I found no evidence in Section 3, 4, 5 or 9 of the ER for this reference. I also checked the corresponding sections of the TR and no such reference was listed. I do not recall any NRC RAI's addressing wildlife so I do not believe it is a result of a RAI response thus, in short, I have no idea where the UW references came from and it dose not appear to come from any of our submittals. Give me a call tomorrow and we can discuss.

ER Section 3.5.5.3.2 – pg 3.5-24 of the ER
Pronghorn antelope (*Antilocapra Americana*) and mule deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*) are the only two big game species that regularly occur in the general analysis area for the Moore Ranch Project. No crucial big game habitat or migration corridors are recognized by the WGFD in this area.

Jon: I am looking for a reference cited in the ER from Section 3.5.5.3.2 that addresses pronghorn and mule deer.

The SEIS has the following extract:

Section 3.6.1.2.1 Big Game

Pronghorn antelope (*Antilocapra Americana*) and mule deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*) are the only two big game species that regularly occur on the proposed license area. No crucial big game habitat or migration corridors occur on or within several kilometers of the area (University of Wyoming, 2004 and 2008).

The U of WY refs cannot be located but in reading the ER, EMC had some studies made and I need the references that address the above issue.
