American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Boiler and Pressure Vessel (B&PV) Code Meeting

During the week of November 1, 2010, the staff participated in the quarterly ASME B&PV Code meetings in Vancouver, British Columbia. The staff participated in a number of meetings throughout the week related to Section III of the ASME B&PV Code, which allowed staff to provide agency views and positions on numerous Section III action items to ensure consistency with NRC regulations and policy. Significant topics of discussion during the week's meetings included, but were not limited to, the use of high-density polyethylene piping in safety-related applications and the status of the NRC's ongoing rulemaking efforts related to the revision to 10 CFR 50.55a.

Issuance of the Safety Evaluation Report Related to the License Renewal of Kewaunee Power Station

On November 4, 2010, the staff issued the Safety Evaluation Report (SER) related to the Kewaunee Power Station license renewal application (LRA). The SER addressed the LRA submitted by Dominion Energy Kewaunee, Inc., by letter dated August 12, 2008. The staff performed its review in accordance with Title 10, Part 54, of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, "Requirements for Renewal of Operating Licenses for Nuclear Power Plants." The current license expires at midnight on December 21, 2013. The staff is scheduled to meet with the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) in a public meeting to be held on December 2, 2010, to discuss the SER.

Issuance of the SER with Open Items Related to the License Renewal of Salem Nuclear Generating Station

On November 4, 2010, the staff issued the SER with Open Items related to the Salem Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1 and 2 (Salem) LRA. The SER addressed the LRA submitted by PSEG Nuclear, LLC, by letter dated August 18, 2009. The SER has four open items related to aging management of buried and underground piping, spent fuel pool leakage, metal fatigue, and steam generator tube-to-tubesheet welds. The staff is scheduled to meet with the ACRS Subcommittee in a public meeting to be held on December 1, 2010, to discuss the SER with Open Items.

Scoping Meetings Held on PSEG ESP Application

On November 4, 2010, the NRC hosted environmental scoping meetings at Salem Community College, Carneys Point, New Jersey, on the PSEG early site permit application for a potential new reactor site adjacent to the Salem and Hope Creek generating stations. These meetings consisted of two sessions to present the environmental review process, to answer questions, and to collect comments on the scope of the environmental review. The majority of comments from both civic and environmental groups supported the Early Site Permit, with some concerned citizens citing impacts to the Delaware River. Prior to the public meetings, the NRC met with other Federal and State agencies, and local officials in a government-to-government meeting.

Exemption Granted to South Texas Project

On November 5, 2010, the NRC granted the South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company an exemption from 10 CFR 50.10 to begin construction activities related to the installation of crane foundation retaining walls for Units 3 and 4.

Public Meeting with Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) on Comparing Integrated Safety Analysis and Probabilistic Risk Assessment

On November 5, 2010, NMSS led a Category 2 public meeting with NEI. The purpose of the meeting was for NRC staff to make a presentation to industry representatives regarding the draft paper comparing Integrated Safety Analyses (ISAs) and Probabilistic Risk Assessments (PRAs), and obtain stakeholder's insight and feedback. The NRC staff indicated that comments on this paper will be accepted by November 19, 2010, and NEI committed to submit a letter to the NRC before the due date. The ISA/PRA comparison paper will be submitted to the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards on December 15, 2010.
