Please find enclosed Amendment Number 01 to NRC License Number 49-29384-01 **consenting to the indirect change of control of this license**. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14)(xi) and 10 CFR 51.22(c)(21). You should review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or if you have any questions, contact me at 817-860-8189.

It is our understanding that on November 16, 2010 ARMZ confirmed that ARMZ and Rosatom commit to abide by Uranium One's commitments with respect to the existing license.

Please note that License Condition 18 was included to ensure NRC is notified of future changes in personnel that may have control over NRC Materials Licenses.

NRC will periodically inspect your radiation safety program. Failure to conduct your program according to NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC may result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation; imposition of a civil penalty; or an order suspending, modifying, or revoking your license as specified in the NRC Enforcement Policy.
