WITHDRAWAL OF RELIEF REQUEST RR-04-03 FOR THE USE OF ASME CODE
CASE N-513-2

In a letter dated March 30, 2010 (ADAMS Ascension No. ML100900200), Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DNC) submitted Relief Request RR-04-03 for the use of American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Code Case N-513-2 (Reference). The duration of the proposed request was for the current Millstone Power Station Unit 2 (MPS2) fourth 10-year inservice inspection interval or until such time as Code Case N-513-3 was accepted for use in a later revision of Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Regulatory Guide (RG) 1.147, "Inservice Inspection Code Case Acceptability, ASME Section XI, Division 1."

In October 2010, the NRC issued RG 1.147, Revision 16, which approved the use of ASME Code Case N-513-3. Because this code case is now endorsed by the NRC, Relief Request RR-04-03 is no longer needed. Hence, DNC hereby withdraws its request for NRC approval of Relief Request RR-04-03.
