
Dear Mr. Flanders:

This is in reference to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Public Meeting pursuant to the intent to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Exelon Victoria County Station's Early Site Permit (ESP). The proposed project is located 12 miles south of Victoria and situated east of SH 77 and west of the Guadalupe River in Victoria County, Texas.

Although the Corps is responsible for making decisions pursuant to Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 and Section 404 of the Clean Water Act for work for which this site is being selected for in the proposed ESP for Exelon, the Corps does not have sufficient resources at this time of continuing resolution funding to attend the proposed meeting.
